

# Danswest Dress Code



## Ballet/Pointe/Prepointe/Stretch

### Female Identifying:

- Level 3+ Solid black leotard  
Mini/Level 1 & 2: Solid light pink leotard
- Tights: Pink or a color closest to their natural skin tone (convertible). Tights may be worn over leotard in level 5+
- All gender hair: must be swept back and up in a secured ballet bun. Braids and locs are accepted but should not exceed a length much lower than the shoulder. The thickness of the braids or locs should allow for a safe, secure, appropriately sized bun that does not move. Dancers with short hair must keep their hair neat, secure, and away from the face.
- Shoes: Canvas or leather ballet shoes to match their tights. Tights must be worn inside of ballet and pointe shoes
- Pre-pointe: Shorts or leggings may be worn over ballet attire
- Stretch: Tight fitting athletic wear or ballet attire w/ shorts/leggings. Bring socks

### Male Identifying:

- Attire: Solid white or black shirt
- Tights: Black, with dance belt

## Tap

- Shoes: Full-sole black lace-up tap shoes. No slip on or split sole. Other colors are acceptable but black will be used for performance.
- Attire: Any movement attire accepted. No street clothes.
- Hair: Hair should be neat, secured, and away from the face.
- Broadway Tap: Heel taps preferred

## Jazz, Lyrical

- Acceptable tops: Leotard, crop top, tank, or tee. Must be form-fitted. No street or school clothes.
- Acceptable bottoms: Leggings, shorts, or jazz pants/studio pants
- Shoes: Black slip-on jazz shoes.
- Hair: Hair should be neat, secured, and away from the face in a ponytail or bun

## Acro/Modern/Contemporary

- Acceptable tops: Leotard, crop top, tank, or tee. Must be form-fitted. No street or school clothes.
- Acceptable bottoms: Leggings, shorts, or studio pants
- No shoe. Class is done barefoot  
Contemporary should bring socks
- Hair: Hair should be neat, secured, and away from the face in a ponytail or bun


## Hip Hop

- Acceptable tops: tee, tank, crop top
- Acceptable bottoms: Leggings, joggers, sweats, studio pants, shorts, athletic pants etc.
- Shoes: Have a dance-class-only pair of sneakers. All-black used for performance.
- Hair: Hair should be neat, secured, and away from the face.

# Preschool Dress Code

## Tiny Dancers

- Girls: Any color leotard and skirt. Tights: pink or skin toned colored convertible tights. Pink ballet shoes.
- Boys: any color T shirt and shorts or athletic pants, black ballet shoes
- Hair: Hair should be, neat, secured, and away from the face.



## Preschool Tap/Ballet

- Girls: Any color leotard and skirt. Tights: pink or skin toned colored convertible tights. Pink ballet shoes.
- Boys: any color T shirt and shorts or athletic pants, black ballet shoes
- Hair: Hair should be neat, secured, and away from the face in a ponytail or bun. Short hair can use clips or a headband



## Kinder Classes

- Ballet Girls: Any color leotard and skirt. Tights: pink or skin toned colored convertible tights. Pink ballet shoes.
- Ballet Boys: any color T shirt and shorts or athletic pants with black ballet shoes
- Other classes: Any form fitted athletic attire or ballet attire with shorts or leggings over the tights.
- Other Footwear: Black tap shoes for tap, all black sneakers for hip hop
- Hair: Hair should be, neat, secured, and away from the face in a ponytail. No jewelry please.
